What is a profound and multiple learning disability?

People who live with profound learning disability and usually:

- Require high levels of support with most aspects of daily life
- Live with additional sensory or physical disabilities, complex health needs, or display behaviours that challenge
- Experience great difficulty communicating

What does a community of practice actually do?

- A network of people who have gained expertise, working in a specific field
- The CoP builds on this diversity to organise its own agenda and activities
- The participants work together to share learning and develop relationships
